A Bow Hunter Education Class is coming to El Dorado Hills Bowmen Friday Evening May 6th & Saturday May 7th. This is The International Bowhunter Education Class that is required in some states and is brought to you in cooperation with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife Hunter Education Program. There is a small fee (\$10.00) for the class and at the end of the class there is a test and you will obtain your Bowhunter Education certificate. If you are interested, please contact me if you have any questions. Registration is required and all registration must be completed on-line, this is new starting in 2016.

Spring is in the air and this means it is Turkey season in California. Turkey hunting in CA is really good if you do a little home work to find a spot. If you are archery hunting turkeys, a good blind is essential to making the most of opportunities. California's 2016 general spring wild turkey hunting season:
