

# El Dorado Hills Bowmen (EDHB)

## Meeting Minutes

August 10, 2022

This month's General Meeting was held at the Range Storage Building. Due to Secretary Segura's travel status, notes were taken by Mr. David McReynolds, which were then inserted into these official minutes.

### 1) Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by David McReynolds, treasurer, at 6:30 PM.

### 2) Attendance

The following were in attendance:

- Board Members – Treasurer David McReynolds, Range Manager Greg Landon, and Member-at-Large Joe Pettus.
- General Membership – Members Michael Ramsbotham, Rob Kunstel, Kerry Gragg, Bill Peterson, and Pete Johnson took the time to attend.

### 3) Treasurer's Report

David McReynolds presented the treasurer's reports for July (no meeting held) and both FEDHPAR and Club accounts. Copies of the monthly financials were sent to Sal Segura for inclusion in the minutes. Highlights included:

#### FEDHPAR

- As of August 8, FEDHPAR has just over \$2,500 in assets. This is after expenditures of over \$7,000 for Range maintenance.
- Frog donations for the month of July totaled \$1,043; through August 8, \$1,110 with an additional \$397 in other-source donations.

#### EDHB

- Current balances continue in a healthy state, despite approximately \$5,000 in expenses over the past months (services, target replacements, and reimbursements to members for out-of-pocket costs).
- Dues income for the month of July totaled \$1,395 and \$1,139 through August 8.

### 4) Secretary's Report

The secretary's report of memberships was presented by David McReynolds. The report was provided by Sal Segura and is summarized below. Member Zahra Bahadori will be handling member processing until Sal's return mid-August.
